A STATE-OF-THE-SCIENCE PROCEDURE: From the convenience of your home, office, or laptop computer, watch William J. Hozack, MD, demonstrate the best-practice, standard of care for hip-joint replacement surgery, using a small incision and briefer operating time. Renowned orthopedic surgeon Richard H. Rothman, MD, PhD, who has helped to pioneer hip replacement techniques, will narrate this live procedure, running approximately 60 minutes.

SHORTER SURGERY, BETTER POST-OP. RESULTS: Using an incision of about four to six inches, Jefferson's surgeons replace the hip joint with less trauma to the surrounding tissue, while keeping the procedure to an unprecedented 35 to 45 minutes in duration, further decreasing the risk of infection.

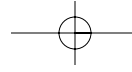

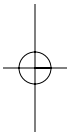
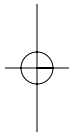
